You have just found out that you are HIV+ (POZ). You think your sex life is over. You think no one will ever love you again. You think that the world holds nothing for you anymore. None of this is true and you do not have to face it alone. You are not the first to feel this way and you will not be the last. There are others who have been there and are willing to help with that pain. They can answer the questions you have.

This is not a twelve step program. There are no dues and no fees. Just friends wanting to help and be there for you.

This support group is designed as a peer-helping initiative. People who are diagnosed as HIV+ can attend this group to meet others who are also POZ. This support group is designed to help others who have just been diagnosed to deal with the disease and its stressors. This group is a safe haven and is exclusive to only people who are POZ (exception given to members of Task Force). **Confidentiality is enforced.**

Contact information and location can be provided by the health department, social services, Western North Carolina AIDS Project (WNCAP) and local doctors. This group is not discriminatory against sexual orientation, gender, or age. HIV shows no compassion, but we do.
